Mrs. Fred Beuch, the former Ethel O'Hern, died on Saturday, July 10 at St. Mary's Hospital, Minneapolis. She had been ill for several months.

Born on February 21, 1917 in Cedar Lake Township, rural Prior Lake, she was the daughter of John O'Hern and Bridget Ryan O'Hern, both now deceased.
