

## Joseph M. Brennan

Funeral services were held of Joseph M. Brennan, formerly of Lakeville, lately of 2000 Dayton Avenue, St. Paul, at All Saints Catholic Church, Lakeville Tuesday, February 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. At the Solemn High Requiem Mass, Rev. Clement Zweber was the celebrant; Rev. Thomas Garvey, deacon; Rev. David Vinck, sub-deacon. Rev. Garvey was from St. Rose Church in St. Paul and Rev. Vinck was from St. Stephens Church, Minneapolis, both were cousins of the deceased.

Burial was in the All Saints Cemetery, with nephews as pallbearers: Francis Ryan, Robert Huberty, John R. Brennan, Charles Kohls, Jr., Joseph Kennealy and Paul Connelly. Visitation was at the White Funeral Home.

Mr. Brennan died in St. Mary's Hospital, Minneapolis, from a heart condition, Saturday, February 3, 1962 at the age of 72 years.

He was born September 6, 1889 at Lakeville, a son of John E. and Marie (Hickey) Brennan. On April 15, 1921, Mr. Brennan was united in marriage with Catherine Connelly. She died May 3, 1942. He was united in marriage with Katheryne Dolan on January 15, 1948.

Survivors are his wife; one niece, who resided with the Brennans is Mrs. Gene (Terry) Reisinger; brothers, John F. of Farmington; William E. of Lakeville; sisters, Mrs. Charles (Mame) Kohls of Farmington; Mrs. Frank (Margaret) Ryan of Jordan; Mrs. Al (Gertrude) Huberty of Minneapolis; a sister, Mrs. Al (Irene) Klotz is deceased. Many other nieces and nephews survive.

Mr. Brennan has been a farmer and a businessman at Lakeville, where he spent practically all his lifetime. He was a member of All Saints Catholic Church in Lakeville and he had a host of friends in that community that mourn his death.
