

Patrick Moran

Mr. Patrick Moran, one of the very few surviving pioneer settlers passed away quietly at his home in Empire last Tuesday morning from Bright's disease. Mr. Moran was born in Westport County, Mayo, Ireland April 9, 1822. He came to this country as a young man and married Catherine Sheridan at Lockport, NY October 16, 1853 locating in Rosemount where they made their home until 1876 when they removed to his late home in the neighboring town. The end was most beautiful and peaceful. He was prepared for death and in fact longed to be reunited to his God and his cherished wife of many years standing whom death separated August 11, 1901. It was the fourth anniversary of the death of his son, Austin. Mr. Moran will be mourned not only by his devoted and bereaved children but by associates of pioneer days and many later friends who learned to love thee genial old man.

Funeral was held from St. Joseph Church, Rosemount at 10 a.m. The Rev. Hugh McDevitt officiated. Interment was in that cemetery by the side of his wife.
